PART 6 (1 of 2) GOD IS HOLY

Introduction

Our Father in heaven hallowed be your name... (May your name be kept holy and treated as sacred.)

- One of the most important things that we can say about God is that he is holy This has been called "the attribute of attributes" yet, it is one of the most difficult things to understand about him.
- ISAIAH 6:1-8 Seraphim called out, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!"
- REVELATION 15:3-4 For you alone are holy.

"Holy"

 The word <u>holy</u> (or <u>sacred</u>) means to be <u>separated</u> or <u>set apart</u>. This is its primary meaning.

It refers to <u>God's nature</u> – that he is set apart, distinct and entirely separate from all others. (This is **God's majestic holiness**.)

The word holy is also used to represent being set apart for the work of God; having relation or contact with God – holy ground, holy sabbath, holy temple, holy of holies, etc..

 Secondarily, the word holy refers to <u>God's character</u>, his **purity**, his absolute moral and ethical excellence. (This is **God's moral holiness**.)

God's Majestic Holiness

- Only God has this attribute it is incommunicable, unique to God, and cannot be shared by humans.
- EXODUS 15:11 Who is like you among the gods,
 O LORD? Who is like you, majestic in holiness...
- REVELATION 4:8 Holy, Holy, Holy is the LORD GOD, the Almighty, who was and who is and who is to come.

"Set Apart"

- **EXODUS 3:1-6** ...you are standing on holy ground.
- 2 PETER 1:16-18 ...with him on the holy mountain.

God's Moral Holiness

- This is a communicable attribute it is infinite in God, but can be shared (partially) by humans.
- **LEVITICUS 19:1-2** You shall be **holy**, for I the LORD your God am **holy**. [NT 1 PETER 1:14-16]
- **EPHESIANS 1:3-4** God chose us in Christ that we should be **holy** and blameless before him...
